## What's Cooking !

### **Striped Delight for the Holidays**

- 35 Oreo Chocolate Sandwich cookies, crushed
- 6 Tbsp. margarine, melted
- 1 pkg. (8 oz) Philadelphia Cream Cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 2 Tbsp cold milk
- 1 tub (12 oz) Cool Whip, thawed and divided
- 3 1/4 cups cold milk
- 2 pkg. (4-serving size each) Jell-o Chocolate Instant Pudding
- Crushed candy cane for sprinkled topping.
- Mix cookie crumbs and butter in medium bowl
- Press firmly into 13 x 9 inch baking dish.
- Refrigerate 10 minutes
- Beat cream cheese, sugar, 2 Tbsp. milk in med bowl.
- Gently stir in 1 1/4 cups of whipped topping.
- Spread over crust.
- Pour 3 1/4 cups milk into large bowl - add pudding mixes—beat with wire whisk 2 minutes.
- Pour over cream cheese—let stand 5 minutes.
- Drop remaining whipped topping by spoonfuls over pudding - spread evenly to cover.
- Sprinkle with crushed candy cane topping.
- Refrigerate at least 4 hours. Cut into 24 squares, 1 inch each.

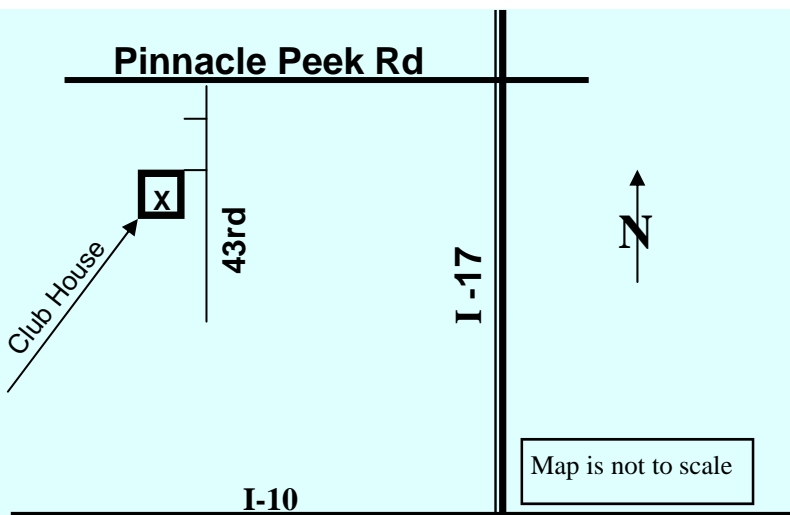
